JUDGE ARMEN TAMZARIAN



Judge Armen Tamzarian has been a Los Angeles Superior Court judge since December 2013. Judge Tamzarian currently has an independent civil calendar assignment. He previously had assignments in civil trial and family law departments. From 2008 to 2013, he served as a senior and lead attorney for Justice Patti Kitching in the California Court of Appeal. From 1997 to 2008, Judge Tamzarian was an associate and then a partner of Case, Knowlson, Jordan & Wright LLP in Los Angeles, where his practice consisted mostly of business litigation. Judge Tamzarian began his legal career as a research attorney at Los Angeles Superior Court.

Sarin Keosian is a Legal Research Attorney within the Superior Court of California, County of San Francisco. Sarin is currently assigned to the Department of the Presiding Judge, where she is responsible for managing the Department's trial and motion calendars. During her tenure with the Court, Sarin has also served as a Legal Research Attorney within various other departments, including the Court's Real Property Department, Asbestos/CEQA Department, Law and Motion Department, Probate Department, and Civil Harassment Department.
